The house was a standard mid-90s builder model two-story house, commonly found in the area. An island with a carefully planned countertop shape transforms the use and flow of the kitchen.

Before



The kitchen had aging cabinets, a decent amount of floor space, peninsula, and a desk. The desk was an important element to the clients. A killer desk was the key to the design.

Before



They clients wanted more storage. A U-shaped kitchen with a peninsula creates to corner cabinets which are traditionally difficult to access and not an efficient use of space.

After



The clients wanted the cabinets to run all the way to the ceiling, but they did not want the standard solution of simply turning 30 inch cabinets into 42 inch cabinets for a tall vertical look. Rather they wanted 12-inch of cabinets along the ceiling, below the standard 30-inch cabinets. This creates a stunning and distinct look.

After



A great, highly-designed desk was important to the clients because it's plays a major role in their daily activities. Printer storage is hidden in a cabinet and the router is concealed. A heirloom telephone sits on the desk, but its cord connection is concealed!

After



Originally, the clients wanted to keep the peninsula but after education on the increase in storage and better access to the dishwasher, they elected to move with a peninsula. A custom paper towel dispenser is integrated into a cabinet drawer.

After



Examine the carefully planned placement of the paper shredder, printer, and keyboard tray in the desk. Note that all cords are concealed. See the herb-growing cabinet integrated into the island.

After



Every need of the client was carefully planned, including their spice drawer and custom paper towel dispenser. The refrigerator and pantry cabinets were placed for symmetry and functionality.

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
